The Healthcare Cluster lays the foundation for the Capital Region's vibrant economy, accounting for one in eight jobs regionwide. Major employers within the cluster include three major hospital systems - Albany Med Health System, St. Peter's Health Partners and Ellis Medicine – as well as several health insurance companies including Capital District Physicians Health Plan (CDPHP) and MVP Health Care. Albany Med has one of the busiest trauma centers in the state and the only children's hospital in northeastern New York. Supporting this large healthcare workforce is an expansive talent pipeline that includes one of New York State's largest teaching hospitals, Albany Medical College, the Albany College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, three nursing schools and several other healthcare-related programs and local colleges and universities. Together they annually award more than 1,900 degrees in health professions and related programs. The region also houses an array of healthcare software solutions firms. The region's largest medical group is **Community Care Physicians (CCP)**.
